SLC FD Relief Association Honors Fallen Firefighters with Plaques

Firefighting is a dangerous job. Over the years the SLC FD has seen its share of tragedy. To honor the Salt Lake City Fire Department members who have died in the line of duty, the SLC FD Relief Association, during the past year, has installed plaques where these firefighters served. President Brady George spearheaded the effort.

The firefighters honored on each plaque and their dates of service are:

Station 1: Harry Christenson, April 22, 1925 – May 19, 1943. Melvon H. Hatch, June 17, 1926 – May 19, 1943. Merrick D. Blake, September 3, 1923 – February 8, 1936. Orson L. Nebecker, January 10, 1947 – March 2, 1975.

Station 2: Theron D. Johnson, August 1, 1942 – May 19, 1943. Paul Hamilton, April 15, 1935 – June 10, 1943.

Station 3: Asa Hall Hancock, August 20, 1906 – July 13, 1920.

Station 4: Alva W. Johnson, January 5, 1931 – May 14, 1944. Robert E. Lee, May 1, 1910 – August 3, 1925.

Station 5: Harland S. Theobald, August 12, 1920 – April 20, 1942. John Robert Spence, December 1, 1953 – September 2, 1967.

Station 6: Kline B. Carroll, June 2, 1943 – December 7, 1946.

Station 7: Andrew L. Thorstrom, July 18, 1914 – April 30, 1929. Timothy E. Hynes, January 5, 1976 – January 11, 1998.
